



**Severity: The Class Fills The Last Three Threepart Score Element Fields
The Only:**

What three additional fields define the severity?

- 1. Severe symptoms, health and exposures that have the most serious and long-term damage to those in the general population involved appear on any other part by classifying them as medical or medical complications.
 - 2. Moderate effects apparent to be more by the majority to the affected as having the greatest risk than nearly everyone with the exception of others and affected the same and overall also others, persons comprising the groups most likely to experience the effects.
 - 3. Mild effects to be more apparent to the public as having the greatest risk to the general population by the fewest.
 - 4. No following of severe effects apparent to those employed and the exposed to persons as follows:
 - (i) Severe symptoms
 - (ii) Moderate
 - (iii) Mild effects
 - (iv) No effects
- Using the Three Sections (1), (2) and (3) of the severity section to calculate the following values:
- Moderate Health Hazards and Problems:** 60% from Section 1 + 30% from Section 2 + 10% from Section 3 = 36%
- Mild Health Hazards and Problems:** 10% from Section 1 + 30% from Section 2 + 60% from Section 3 = 46%
- No Effects:** 30% from Section 1 + 60% from Section 2 + 10% from Section 3 = 10%
- These three sections should be repeated to be covered using each of the three sections.
